

TEMPLATE IS IN 2 LAYERS

- Guides (Non-printable Layer)
- Design

SAFE AREA:

Keep all copy within the "Safe Area" to ensure it doesn't get cut off.

BLEED SIZE:

Make sure the artwork extends to the Bleed Area in order to ensure that the page is printed properly.
